Public Notice of the City of Ocala Canvassing Board for the September 16 General Election is hereby given. The Canvassing Board Members consist of Angel Jacobs, William Sexton, and Wesley Wilcox. The City of Ocala Canvassing Board will meet at the dates and times listed below:

September 9 at 3:00 pm, to conduct the pre-election testing of the ballot tabulating equipment;
September 15 at 9:30 am, to canvass and duplicate ballots; September 16 at 5:00 pm, to canvass and duplicate ballots and oversee the conduct of the election until election night activities are concluded;
September 18 at 5:01 pm, to canvass and duplicate ballots, file official results and randomly select the race and precincts to audit; September 19 at 2:00 pm, to conduct the post-election audit.

If the Board is required to meet at dates and times not listed, the time, date, location, and activity will be posted on the Supervisor of Elections web site: www.VoteMarion.Gov, posted at the entrance of the Election Center, and announced at the conclusion of the preceding meeting.

All meetings of the Canvassing Board are open to the public and will be conducted at the Supervisor of Elections Office at the Election Center, 981 NE 16th Street, Ocala, Florida 34470. Persons with disabilities requiring special accommodations to participate should call the Supervisor of Elections Office at 352-620-3290 at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.

Any person who decides to appeal any decision of the Canvassing Board with respect to any matter considered at this meeting will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, may need to hire a stenographer to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
